At a regular meeting of the Township Board of Trustees of New Haven Township, on February 12, 2024 at 2705 Easton Rd Owosso Mi, 48867 at 7Pm:

The following Resolution were offered by Wirwicki

WHEREAS, the Township Board New Haven wishes to provide SATA (Shiawassee Area Transportation Agency) Public Transportation; and

WHEREAS, townships may impose and levy ad valorem property taxes to finance lawful public services, as authorized by the Michigan Constitution of 1963 and other laws; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board of New Haven, Shiawassee County wishes to renew the current levy, .333 mills to provide SATA (Shiawassee Area Transportation Agency) Public Transportation;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED, the Township Board of New Haven, Shiawassee County, approves the following millage ballot question language and directs the Clerk to submit it to be place on the August, 6, 2024

Ballot Proposal

Shall New Haven Township renew the previously voted 1/3 of a mill levy (0.333 per \$1,000.00 taxable value of real property) each year on an ad valorem basis, for a term of two (2) years (2024, 2025 tax year)? Such millage to be used to provide funding to the Shiawassee Area Transportation Agency (SATA) so that Township residents can ride public transportation at a reduced charge.

It is estimated that the Township will levy up to \$17,184 in the first year if the millage is approved.


